LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS – A ball lying beyond the boundaries of Horizons property or in any planted farmland or on the water catchments is out of Bounds.

NEWLY PLANTED TREES – If a player risk any damage to new plantings of trees, he must lift and drop so as to avoid such damage. No penalty.

PUTTING GREEN – The practice putting green is to be treated as a part of the 5th & 9th (14th & 18th) greens. Rule 35-1 (i) applies.

OLEANDERS – If the oleanders in the bunker behind the 6th green interfere with a player's stroke, the ball may be lifted and dropped in the bunker without penalty as near as possible to where the ball lay so as to give relief from this interference.

PLEASE MAINTAIN CAUTION when playing over pathways and near cottages.

TO PRESERVE THE TURF – It is requested that players use wooden pegs on the teeing grounds.

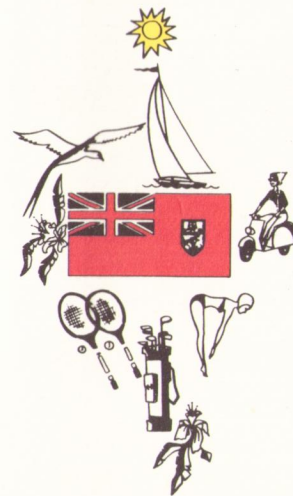
